- Suggestions are Scotch Removable Poster Tape, reusable poster, putty, Command Strips, and Crafty Tack
- Please be aware that any use of hot glue must be removed and wall paint remain intact
- Please avoid duct tape on walls
- Decorating begins Tuesday, September 27, at 8:30 A.M.
- Decorating completed Wednesday, September 28, at 4:00 P.M.
- Judging will be Thursday, September 29, at 8:30 A.M.
