



Clarksville Academy Dress Code Guidelines

Students' dress should enhance, not disrupt, the educational process.

Below are specific guidelines for appropriate school day apparel. When in question of any of the stated guidelines, please consult with your direct Head of School.

1. Classic/modest length and fit styles of all clothing are acceptable.
2. Jeggings/leggings may be worn with tunic style tops or dresses only.
3. Students may wear sleeveless shirts provided the garment has two-inch straps and covers the front, side, and back completely.
4. Shirts must cover the midriff at all times. Low cut or off the shoulder clothing is not permitted.
5. At no time should any undergarment be visible.
6. Distressed clothing is permitted provided that no skin is visible above the fingertips.
7. During the school day, athletic shorts and other athletic clothing are not allowed.
8. Shirts with logos, brands, or phrasing should be school appropriate and not contain offensive humor, weapons, profane language, or innuendo.
9. No caps, hats/hoods, or sunglasses are allowed to be worn indoors during the school day.
10. Shoes must be worn at all times and be appropriate for the events and activities for the day.
11. Electronic headsets, earbuds, or other listening devices should not be in use during assembly, during class without teacher permission, or while walking around campus.
12. Facial hair should be kept neat and not be a distraction.
13. Only piercings in the ear/ears are permitted.

**Administration/faculty reserves the right to consult with any student on attire that is deemed inappropriate. After an initial warning, or for extreme violations, parents are expected to bring a change of clothes in order for the student to return to class.*

Hair Requirements for All Students: Hair should be clean, styled, and out of students' eyes. While modern hairstyles are acceptable, students' hair should never be a distraction to the school community (ie. hair dyed an unnatural color).
